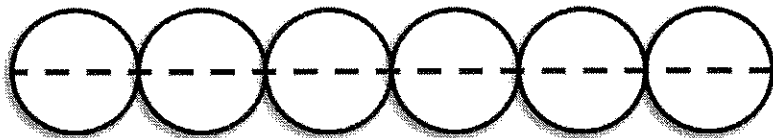

Christmas Programs

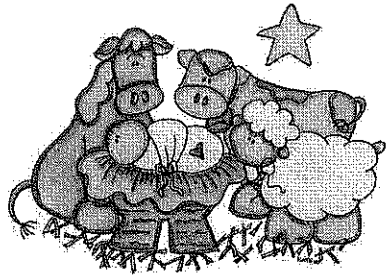

Christmas Parade


