### Principal's Corner

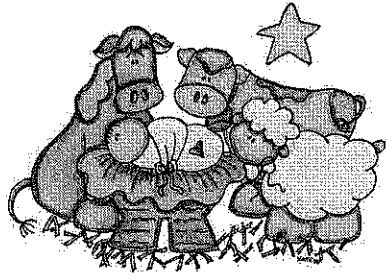
